Greetings!

I think, you all are aware that beginning of this month, there was a big flood occurred in Bangladesh and many people have lost their houses, crops and valuable household items. Especially, the poor people are now living very inhumane situation. They are not getting sufficient food, cooking and toilet facilities, even they are not able to repair their damaged houses.

Our government has distributed some relief for the affected people, but it was not enough for them. So, on behalf of NGOs, we tried our best to provide some dry food, ORS, water purifying tablet, Candle and cloths for the affected people. Now, due to using polluted water, they have been suffering from many diseases. As we have a project in Munshigonj district (which is severe flood affected area), we can understand, what sufferings they are facing now. So, we are trying to collect some money for purchasing some items as per their need. You know, my organization (PDAP) is a small organization, and we don't have enough capacity to overcome this situation alone.

I would like to inform you that one of our friend Ms. Lena Hicks (from USA) has come forward to assist our flood affected people. She has contributed some funds to the following account for our affected people. On behalf of our beneficiaries, I am very much grateful to her for her so kindness. We are planning to start our next action from next week.
